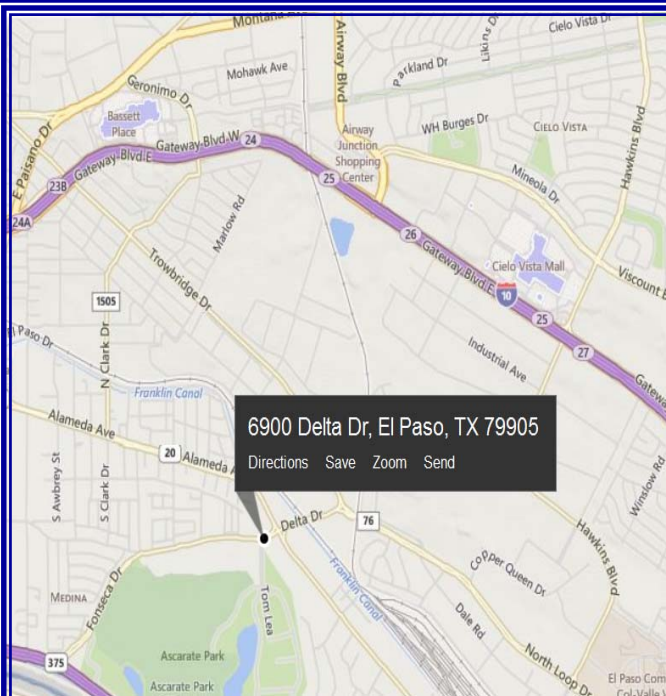

# Science and Nature Activities in the Park!



Texas A&M AgriLife Extension is proud to bring a youth STEM camp for students ages 9-12 to Ascarate Park. The week long camp offers a fun, safe, educational environment to learn, explore, build self confidence and be creative. All fun filled science sessions are led by Extension Educators and certified Extension Master volunteers.



## Hands-on Learning

Within Ascarate Park, youth campers will participate in several hands on activities and projects focusing on sustainability, natural resource conservation and environmental stewardship. Students will have fun while learning about nutrition in our Vegetable Teaching Gardening, with our TEKs aligned Junior Master Gardener Curriculum. Campers will build rockets and learn about solar energy. Nature appreciation activities such as catch and release fishing at Ascarate Lake will be included in our wildlife habitat unit.

## Leadership Activities

Students will participate in our 4-H youth leadership curriculum included for team building exercises. Students will also show off what they've learned at the FAMILY DAY celebration on Saturday with the Family Food Challenge. The camp will end with swimming at the aquatics center.
