Texas 4-H Shooting Sports Program

Coach's Certification Workshop March 18 - 19, 2022 – El Paso, Texas

The Texas 4-H Shooting Sports Program has scheduled a workshop just for **YOU**. Volunteers with an interest in working with youth to help them develop personal responsibility and other life skills can become trained and certified coaches within the Texas 4-H Shooting Sports program by attending this workshop. In addition to teaching valuable life skills, coaches work with youth to teach good marksmanship, the safe and responsible use of firearms, conservation ethics, and more.

The workshop is conducted by nationally certified instructors and provides in-depth training on working with youth through the shooting sports program. Coaches can become certified in <u>Archery</u>, <u>Shotqun</u>, <u>Pistol</u>, or <u>Rifle, & Muzzleloading</u>. Participate as: Adult Coach (21 yrs \uparrow , Asst. Coach (18-20 yrs), Youth Asst. Coach (14-18 yrs). Restrictions apply.

Poster Board Competition

Students begin by selecting a species or habitat management tool to research and build their project around. They put together a comprehensive scientific poster board that will be judged using a series of criteria aimed at awarding the students for their valid research, thorough expression of the issues related to that species or habitat, and their recommendations for action to take. Oral presentations wrap up the judging with individual and chapter cash prizes awarded during the Ranching & Wildlife Expo.

Video Competition

Videos must be 1-3 minutes long and can be filmed on anything from a digital video camera to a smartphone. As with the Poster Board Competition, the content should depict aspects of conservation and/or enhancement of native Texas wildlife habitat with appeal to a public audience. Topics may include subjects such as plant or wildlife species, native Texas habitat, or a ranching/wildlife management technique or practice, but participants have the latitude to find a topic that interests them.

2023 Texas 4-H Dog Show T-shirt Contest

Entry Submission Rules & Guidelines:

- Must be a 4-H member (single entry submission)
- Can use two ink colors in addition to the color of the shirt. Example: If the design calls for red, white and blue, one of those colors should be the color of the shirt. Do not select white as the shirt color choice.
- · The design should fit on the front side of the t-shirt (12 inch design maximum)
- Be creative and develop an original design
- Simple designs are more effective and easier to screen print. Designs may have to be modified slightly to include the proper clover logo and to clean up details.
- Entries should be emailed to Cory.hundl@ag.tamu.edu by February 15, 2023
- Must be JPEG or PNG format
- · Include the following in your email:
 - 4-H Member's Name
 - Grade
 - County
 - Attach Image/Design
- · Entries will be judged based on 4-H Age Divisions
 - Clover Kids (K-2nd grade)
 - Junior (3rd 5th)
 - Intermediate (6th 8th)
 - Senior (9th 12th)
- An overall design will be selected from the first place entries of each age division listed above

National 4-H Conference APRIL 14-19, 2023

The U.S. Department of Agriculture's (USDA) National Institute of Food and Agriculture (NIFA) will host the 2023 National 4-H Conference April 14-19, 2023 in-person at the Hyatt Regency Crystal City in Arlington, Virginia.

NIFA has administered the National 4-H Conference on behalf of the Secretary of Agriculture in Washington, DC since 1927. Known as "the Secretary's Conference," this Conference is the flagship youth development opportunity of USDA. Today, the Conference remains true to its original intent to develop the next generation of leaders while continuing to be future focused. The Conference brings together young people, volunteer leaders, county and state Extension staff, Land-grant University faculty and administrators, as well as state and federal government officials from across the United States and its Territories. During the Conference, delegates will become familiar with the government and future career opportunities and share their voice with federal agencies and congressional committees.

National 4-H Conference is open to 4-H Youth (ages 15-18).

Applications to attend will be open from December 7, 2022 - December 15, 2022. Selected delegates will be announced early January 2023.

Estimated cost between \$2,000-2,250. Will have a better idea on cost once information is received from Nationals on December 7th.
